What does Heseḏ mean?

Heseḏ (pronounced kheh-sed") The Bible describes God's unconditional or loyal love for us using this Hebrew word. Heseḏ is "wrapping up in itself all the positive attributes of God: love, covenant faithfulness, mercy, grace, kindness, loyalty—in short acts of devotion & loving-kindness that go beyond the requirements of duty," elaborates Bible scholar Darrell L. Bock.
